Activity levels on these holidays

Our holidays are not physically demanding, but you do need to be capable of a certain amount of unassisted walking to enable you and your fellow travellers to enjoy the holiday to the maximum. As a general rule if you can walk one mile and climb two flights of stairs (normal household equivalent), unassisted at a normal pace then you should be able to manage most of the day to day itineraries of our holidays. There may be uneven footpaths to negotiate as well as steps.

Our Tour Managers will help to a certain extent but do bear in mind they are there for the whole group.

On some days, you will notice a  symbol, which show you at a glance which excursions require a more moderate amount of walking and steps and may be considerably more than the above requirements.

For those considering our **Rhine** or **Danube** cruises where the symbol applies, you may wish to take the opportunity on those occasions to remain on board where you can relax and enjoy the ships facilities.

If you are considering our **Cairo & Nile** or **Shanghai, Yangtze and Hong Kong** holidays, the nature of the holiday means that you are likely to be moving about more, and we advise you to think about how to adjust to being in a different time zone, and differences in climate.

In general, for safety reasons, we require that all guests are able to cope reasonably with the demands of the holiday arrangements without assistance from our Tour Manager or your fellow travellers. Please make sure that you have fully understood the level of activity and ability required to complete the holiday on which you are booking. If unsure, contact our team for advice.

Please read section 15.3 of our booking conditions (in the back of this brochure). You can also contact us and request our detailed mobility guidelines (which both also appear on our website).

Stress-free visa applications

EASY AND WE DO IT ALL FOR YOU!

We are experienced in dealing with the procedures of visa applications and – for a charge – will take care of as much of this process as possible for you. Only the **Cairo & Nile** and **Shanghai, Yangtze cruise and Hong Kong** holidays have visa requirements. Once you have booked, we send a simple form for you to complete with full instructions on the application process should you wish us to do this on your behalf. Your passport must have two blank pages and be valid for six months after your date of return. All our other destinations have no visa requirements but your passport must be valid for six months after your return.

EGYPT – CAIRO & NILE CRUISE

British passport holders travelling to Egypt normally require a visa. For visits of up to 30 days, you can get a visa on arrival by payment in Sterling, US Dollars or Euros; the visa fee is approx US \$28 at approved bank kiosks within airport arrival halls, before reaching immigration counters. We can pre-arrange this so that our representative in Cairo has this all done when you land to save time queuing on arrival and additional hassle (getting you to the hotel quicker!) for a fee of £35. We will add this to your booking if you choose this option. A landing card is presented on board the aircraft to be completed in preparation for arrival procedures.

CHINA – SHANGHAI, YANGTZE CRUISE & HONG KONG

Due to our convenient and special arrangement with the Chinese authorities' your entry into China currently will be by means of a group visa. All we will require from you is a colour photocopy or scan of the picture page of your passport and a passport photo taken on a plain white background.

This holiday includes a personal audio guide throughout

DAY 1 TRAVEL TO AMSTERDAM

Morning: meet your Tour Manager at Heathrow and depart on your direct scheduled flight to Amsterdam. On arrival transfer and embark MS Swiss Crystal where the friendly crew will welcome you aboard. If flying from a regional airport you will be met by our representative and escorted to the ship.

Afternoon: included lunch buffet on arrival before settling in to your cabin, your home for the next eleven nights. In the late afternoon enjoy an included canal cruise. There is no better way to see Amsterdam than by boat, cruising along elegant canals (grachten), lined by stately homes that date back to Amsterdam's 'Golden Age'. Afternoon tea and coffee will be served once back on board MS Swiss Crystal.

Evening: over a welcome drink, meet the crew and receive a brief introduction from your two One Traveller Tour Managers before a table d'hôte dinner. All lunches and dinners on board are freshly prepared and are accompanied by unlimited house wines, beer, soft drinks, tea and coffee.

L **AT** **D**

DAY 2 AMSTERDAM – KEUKENHOF GARDENS

Morning: dubbed the 'most beautiful spring garden in the world' Keukenhof Gardens, situated in the Dutch town of Lisse, becomes a myriad of colour for just eight weeks a year.

Mid-afternoon: return to the ship where there will be time to wander Amsterdam or perhaps visit the famous Rijksmuseum with its collection of Dutch and Flemish masterpieces. Later set sail for an evening cruising the Dutch countryside.

Evening: like all evenings gather before dinner for a short port talk on the following day and mingle with your fellow shipmates before enjoying a table d'hôte dinner with drinks included.

Lunch will be at your own cost today. The lunch on day one has been included in replacement of this due to the early flight and to allow as much time as possible in the gardens.

B **AT** **D**

DAY 3 NIJMEGEN – A BRIDGE TOO FAR TOUR

Morning: Nijmegen, synonymous with the ill-fated Operation Market Garden devised by Field Marshal Bernard Montgomery in an attempt to shorten the war in the autumn of 1944. The goal was to capture three key bridges across the Rhine. Your tour will visit Arnhem and the John Frost Bridge, the Airborne Museum and the poignant Commonwealth War Cemetery at Oosterbeek as well as the landing places at Wolfheze to gain a

fascinating insight and pay tribute to this momentous battle and its fallen.

Afternoon: cruise deep in the heart of Holland towards Cologne, passing flower bedecked houseboats, flocks of wildfowl and windmills.

Evening: table d'hôte dinner with drinks included.

B **L** **AT** **D**

DAY 4 COLOGNE

Morning: after breakfast disembark for a guided tour of Cologne. Founded as a Roman colony at the intersection of major trade routes and a centre of pilgrimage, the iconic cathedral stands out across the city's skyline.

Afternoon: after lunch on board wander into Cologne at your own pace and perhaps visit the fragrant home of the famous Eau de Cologne or the Schildergasse, one of Germany's most famous shopping streets. As always afternoon tea and coffee will be available on board.

Evening: table d'hôte dinner with drinks included.

DAY 5 COCHEM AND WINE TASTING

Morning: sail the Moselle through the narrowest and most unspoilt stretches dotted with castles, vineyards and sleepy wine-growing villages. MS Swiss Crystal will negotiate deep bends as she meanders between the hills and slopes of the Eifel.

Holiday highlights

Keukenhof Gardens

An incredible seven million bulbs are planted annually throughout the 79-acre park, with bright pink tulips, golden daffodils and deep blue-hued hyacinths becoming just some of the floral star attractions in the seven themed gardens on show here. Now the second largest flower garden in the world, the sheer size and beauty of these extraordinary gardens is sure to amaze both gardeners and non-gardeners alike.

Ehrenbreitstein Fortress

Enjoy a cable car ride across the river and at 118 metres high, the fortress has the most fantastic views over Koblenz and the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. The Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, the second largest preserved fortress in Europe, was constructed in its present form between 1817 and 1828. Its origin dates back to the year 1000.

Afternoon: in former times Cochem was the centre of the Moselle wine trade. From the ship enjoy unrivalled views of the castle crowning a mound covered in vineyards. A short walking tour is included before transferring to the castle and later enjoy a wine tasting of Moselle wines.

Evening: as you set sail to leave the Moselle, to re-join the Rhine, enjoy the Captain's dinner with drinks included.

DAY 6 TRIER

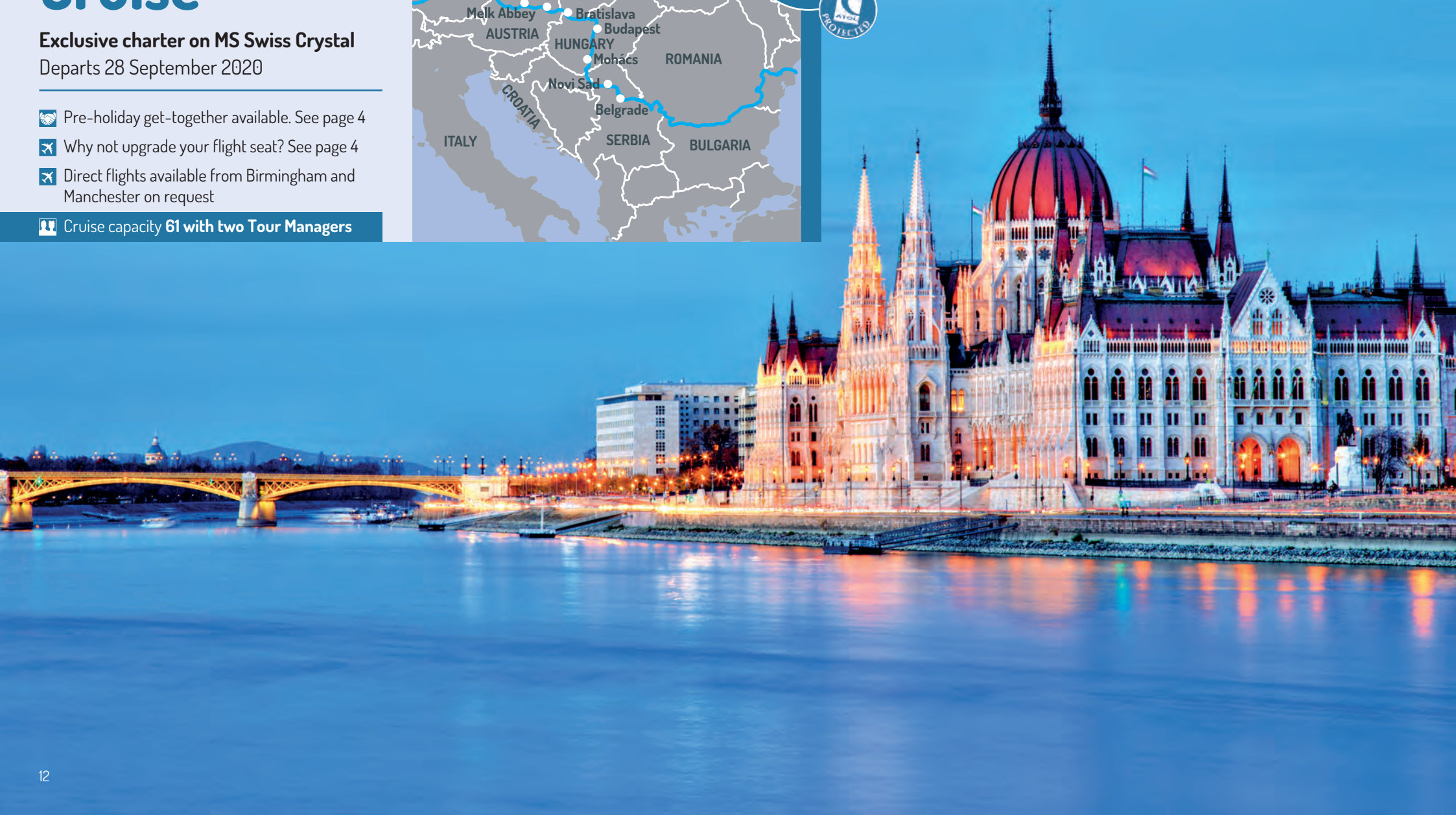

It is one of the most important Romanesque monuments from the time of the Holy Roman Empire.

Kitchener's Island, to the west of Elephantine Island, was given to Lord Horatio Kitchener in the 1890s when he was commander of the Egyptian army. Indulging his passion for beautiful palms and plants, Kitchener turned the entire island into stunning Botanical Gardens, importing plants from the Far East, India and parts of Africa.

DAY 1 FLY TO CAIRO

Meet your Tour Managers and travelling companions at Heathrow Airport and fly direct to Cairo with British Airways. On arrival you will be met by our local representative who will assist with immigration and customs formalities. You will transfer by coach to the Marriott Hotel on the Nile and check in for a three-night stay.

DAY 2 EGYPTIAN MUSEUM, CITADEL AND KHAN AL-KHALILI BAZAAR

Morning: a full day in Cairo starting with the Egyptian Museum, which covers 5,000 years of Egypt's past and contains the world's most extensive collection of Pharaonic antiquities. No visit to Egypt is complete without a trip through its galleries, including the Royal Mummy Room. From the museum we continue to The Saladin Citadel of Cairo. The location on Mokattam Hill near the centre of Cairo is a monument to medieval warfare and has impressive views of the city. It is now preserved as an historic site, with the Mohamed Ali mosque at its centre.

Afternoon: lunch will be in a local restaurant before visiting the Khan Al-Khalili Bazaar. Once the economic hub of Cairo at the time of the sultans the shops – many arranged around small courtyards – stock everything from household goods to semi-precious stones and souvenirs. There will be free time to explore the bazaar before returning to the hotel.

Evening: welcome drinks party followed by dinner at the hotel.

B L D

DAY 3 THE PYRAMIDS OF GIZA, MEMPHIS AND SAQQARA

Morning: visit to the Great Pyramid, the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza complex. This is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one to remain largely intact. See the great Sphinx of Giza, a limestone statue of a mythical creature with the body of a lion and a human face.

Afternoon: we include lunch at the delightful and historic Mena House before a visit to the ancient capital of Memphis and Saqqara. Although most visitors associate Egypt with the Pyramids of Giza there are known to be at least 118 ancient pyramids scattered around the country. The Step Pyramid of Zoser in the Saqqara necropolis was built during the 27th century BC and was the largest building of its time.

Evening: pre-dinner drinks followed by dinner at the hotel.

DAY 4 FLY TO LUXOR

Morning: depart for the short flight to Luxor, the site of the ancient city of Thebes and frequently called 'the world's greatest open-air museum'. The ruins of the temples at Karnak and Luxor stand within the modern city and across the Nile, immediately opposite, lie the monuments, temples and tombs of the West Bank Necropolis. This includes the Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens.

Afternoon: on arrival in Luxor board the five-star MS Jaz Regency, your home for the next seven nights, on a full board basis with an all-inclusive drinks package. Guests enjoy a high crew-to-guest ratio and an excellent level of attentive service.

Evening: welcome drinks get-together with the crew, followed by dinner with included drinks and entertainment.

DAY 5 KARNAK AND LUXOR TEMPLES

Morning: Karnak lies a mile and a half south of the modern city of Luxor, built on the site of Thebes, the City of a Hundred Gates. During the New Kingdom period (1550-1069 BC) Thebes was the all-powerful capital of Egypt, and Karnak was its heart. The temple complex grew in stages over 1,500 years, added to by successive generations of pharaohs, and the resulting collection of sanctuaries, kiosks, pylons and obelisks acts as a vast

open-air archive of history set in stone. The beautiful Luxor Temple is by the side of the Nile and is one of the most beguiling of Egypt's pharaonic monuments. It is just a short stroll from your ship.

Afternoon: buffet lunch on board as we sail towards Edfu. This afternoon you can relax and watch the scenery while enjoying afternoon tea and cakes.

Evening: pre-dinner drinks followed by dinner and entertainment.

B L AT D

DAY 6 EDFU AND THE TEMPLE OF HORUS

Morning: arrive in Edfu and visit the Temple of Horus. Edfu is located on the west bank of the Nile River between Esna and Aswan, with a population of approximately 60,000 people. The Temple of Horus is the best-preserved ancient temple structure in Egypt. The temple as it stands was started in 237 BC on the site of an earlier New Kingdom structure, and completed almost two centuries later in 57 BC by the father of Cleopatra. The monumental gateway is guarded by twin granite falcons, representing the deities Horus and Hathor.

Afternoon: buffet lunch on board and a free afternoon to relax with afternoon tea and cakes.

Evening: pre-dinner drinks and dinner.

B L AT D

DAY 7 ASWAN - HIGH DAM - SOUND AND LIGHT SHOW

Morning: the Aswan Dam is built across the Nile and its construction became a key part of the plan to control floods, provide water for irrigation, and generate hydroelectricity. Constructed 1960-70 this feat of engineering has had a significant effect on the economy and culture of Egypt. Aswan was also the source of Egypt's finest granite, used by the ancient Egyptians to make statues and to embellish temples, pyramids and obelisks. We visit the Northern Quarries, where there is a huge discarded obelisk, which would have been the largest of all, but a flaw appeared in the rock at a late stage in the process, so it lies abandoned. We also visit the islands of Philae and the temples which house monuments of various eras, extending from the Pharaohs to the Caesars.

Afternoon: buffet lunch on board followed by free time to relax with afternoon tea served on deck.

Evening: drinks and dinner, followed by another visit to the Philae Temple to watch a Sound and Light Show. This interesting show narrates the legends of the Goddess Isis and the God Osiris in words, light and music. Walk through the temple, enjoy the fantastic panoramic view and listen to the stories unfold.

DAY 8 ABU SIMBEL AND THE ASWAN BOTANICAL GARDEN BY FELUCCA

Morning: at leisure or take a short flight for the pre-booked excursion to Abu Simbel. The temple complex was saved from the rising waters of Lake Nasser during the construction of the Aswan Dam, in a massive archaeological rescue plan sponsored by UNESCO in the 1960s. The complex dedicated to the Pharaoh Ramses II remains an evocative and unforgettable destination.

Afternoon: visit the Aswan Botanical Garden by felucca, the traditional Egyptian sailboat. Kitchener's Island, to the west of Elephantine Island, was given to Lord Horatio Kitchener ('Your Country Needs You') in the 1890s when he was commander of the Egyptian army. Indulging his passion for beautiful palms and plants, Kitchener turned the entire island into a stunning botanical garden, importing plants from India, South-East Asia and other parts of Africa.

Evening: pre-dinner drinks followed by dinner.

DAY 9 KOM OMBO AND THE SOBEK TEMPLE

Morning: set sail early to Kom Ombo and enjoy a visit to the Sobek Temple. Dedicated to Sobek the crocodile god, and Horus the falcon-headed god, the temple has two of everything, each half devoted to one god. Captive crocodiles were kept within the temple and many mummified crocodiles have been found in nearby cemeteries. Examples can be seen in the small Chapel of Hathor.

Afternoon: lunch on board, followed by an afternoon to relax and enjoy the Nile scenery as you sail towards Luxor with afternoon tea served on deck.

Evening: pre-dinner drinks get-together, followed by dinner and entertainment.

B L AT D  

DAY 10 VALLEY OF KINGS, THE COLOSSI OF MEMNON AND QUEEN HATSHEPSUT

Morning: nestled in the cliffs on the west bank of the Nile at Luxor is The Valley of the Kings, one of the world's richest archaeological sites. On first appearance it is just a sun-scorched, arid valley between steep-sided hills. However, during the greatest period in ancient Egyptian history, practically every pharaoh was buried here, in deeply sunk tombs of extraordinary beauty decorated from floor to ceiling with mysterious images of the

afterlife. We include entrance to Tutankhamun's tomb. We will then continue to the Colossi of Memnon, which lie beside the road to the West Bank monuments, two massive stone statues which are virtually all that remains of one of Egypt's greatest temples. Finally we see the Temple of Hatshepsut, ancient Egypt's only female pharaoh, in its superb setting, rising in a series of broad terraces that join at the top with the limestone cliffs.

Afternoon: buffet lunch on board followed by free time to explore Luxor and visit the bazaar almost opposite your mooring, to purchase those final gifts. Maybe simply relax on board and enjoy a final few hours of winter sun. Afternoon tea is served on deck.

Evening: farewell drinks followed by dinner.

DAY 11 RETURN TO CAIRO - FAREWELL DINNER

Hangzhou's dreamy West Lake panoramas and fabulous green hills have been eulogised by poets and applauded by emperors, while the lake has intoxicated the Chinese imagination for aeons. Kept spotlessly clean by armies of street sweepers, its scenic vistas draw you into a classical Chinese watercolour of willow-lined banks, mist-covered hills and the occasional shikūmēn (stone-gate house) and old lilōng (residential lane).

Hong Kong: Po Lin Monastery

Hong Kong's remote Po Lin Monastery, hidden away on lush mountainsides, became a popular attraction when the extraordinary Tian Tan Buddha statue (informally known as the Big Buddha) was erected in 1993. Sitting 34 metres high and facing north to look over the Chinese people, this majestic bronze Buddha draws pilgrims from all over Asia.

DAY 1 TRAVEL FROM THE UK TO SHANGHAI

Suzhou is known for its silk production and there will also be a chance to visit a silk embroidery centre.

Afternoon: lunch in Suzhou before continuing to Hangzhou, once declared by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and elegant city in the world", a true contrast to the hustle and bustle of Shanghai. On arrival check in to your hotel for a three-night stay.

Evening: dinner in a local restaurant and a first chance to wander the magnificent West Lake in the evening.

DAY 6 HANGZHOU – FOUNTAIN SHOW

Morning: visit Lingyinsi, the Temple of the Soul's Retreat which got its name because of the tranquil surroundings. Sheltered by forested hills on three sides, the temple is a quiet and serene sanctuary which holds the largest statue of the Buddha Sakyamuni in the lotus position.

Afternoon: continue to a traditional tea village. Hangzhou is famous for its West Lake Dragon Well Tea, considered to be China's best tea. Whilst visiting one of the tea houses you will enjoy a traditional tea ceremony and taste several varieties with various tastes and differing health benefits.

Evening: dinner in a local restaurant followed by a spectacular fountain show, where thousands of jets of water dance to music and lights in this wonderful lakeside setting.

DAY 7 HANGZHOU – WEST LAKE

Morning: stroll this elegant scenic spot with your guide and enjoy a cruise to Fairy Island, a man-made island that was constructed in 1607. The island contains a smaller lake, and inside that a smaller island. The entire island is covered by pagodas and walkways, and the different parts are linked by bridges. Afterwards, continue to the Six Harmonies Pagoda with its scenic vista overlooking the lake.

Afternoon: after lunch the afternoon is free to relax or continue to enjoy the lake area or some of the quaint narrow shopping streets of Hangzhou.

Evening: dinner in the hotel.

DAY 8 FLY TO THE YANGTZE

Morning: fly to Yichang 'the Gateway to the Three Gorges' on the banks of the Yangtze River and transfer to lunch.

Afternoon: mountains and forest dominate the landscape to the west of the city, while to the east lies a vast, fertile plain. The construction of the nearby Gezhouba Dam, which started operations in 1981, turned Yichang from a small city into a large one. If time permits you will take a tour of Yichang before boarding your five-star cruise ship in Mao Ping (90 mins drive) for a four-night cruise.

Evening: welcome dinner on board.

**DAY 9 CRUISE - THREE GORGES DAM**

Morning: visit the Three Gorges Dam at San Dou Ping, the largest in the world.

Afternoon: enjoy lunch and sail through the Three Gorges Dam, then through the Xiling Gorge, the longest (41 miles), and the deepest of the Three Gorges.

Evening: dinner and entertainment on board.

**DAY 10 CRUISE - WU AND QUTANG GORGES**

Morning: transfer to smaller boats for the Goddess Stream, a tributary where you will see cascading waterfalls, steep cliffs, karst caves, and an amazing array of wildlife and monkeys as they play near the water's edge. The gorge is so narrow that the walls above almost touch at a place known as Yixiantian, which means 'a rift in the sky'.

Afternoon: enjoy lunch and sail through the Wu Gorge, known for its quiet beauty, forest-covered mountains and sheer cliffs. Then sail through Qutang Gorge, the shortest, narrowest and most dramatic gorge.

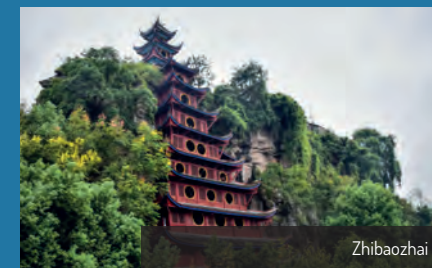

The following booking conditions form the basis of your contract with One Traveller Limited. Please read them carefully as they set out our respective rights and obligations. By asking us to confirm your booking, we are entitled to assume that you have read these booking conditions and agree to them.

1. CONTRACTS & BOOKING FORM

A contract is only entered into when One Traveller Ltd. has issued a Holiday Confirmation Invoice either electronically or by post. The Holiday Confirmation Invoice is issued once we have received your deposit payment.

Booking Form

A completed and signed Booking Form must be returned to us as soon as possible to ensure we have your correct and up-to-date details. This then enables us to comply with the appropriate authorities and their requirements.

2. PAYMENTS AND BOOKING

2.1. An initial deposit is required together with your booking. The amount of deposit required depends on the type of holiday you are booking. The balance payment due date on a holiday also varies depending on the holiday you are booking. The following table details both these things:

If we are unable to confirm a particular hotel or cabin grade stated in our brochure or website, we will endeavour to secure an acceptable alternative of a similar standard. If we are unable to confirm your holiday on your preferred date we will do our best to move you to an alternative date convenient to you alternatively any monies paid will be refunded in full.

2.2. If making a part payment towards your balance, the smallest amount we accept is £350.

2.3. We reserve the right at our discretion to decline any booking application.

3. CANCELLATION BY YOU

3.1. You may cancel your holiday at any time, provided that the person named on the booking form confirms the cancellation in writing. Your cancellation is taken from the date we receive your letter or email (admin@onetraveller.co.uk).

3.2. As cancellation incurs administrative costs and many suppliers require advance payments, we will apply cancellation charges as set out below:

3.3. However, we will endeavour to recover payments made to our suppliers which will be returned to you after taking into account local cancellation penalties and after deducting a reasonable amount for our administration costs.

3.4. Please note that fares paid for flight upgrades are not recoverable.

3.5. Pre-Holiday Get-Togethers cancelled within 28 days of departure are non-refundable.

4. DEPOSIT GUARANTEE SCHEME

If you cancel your holiday prior to the balance due date stated on your invoice your deposit will be protected by us under our 'guaranteed deposit scheme' as long as the cancellation is not a result of non-payment or any other breach of these terms and conditions. This means that 50% of your original deposit paid to us at the time of booking will be kept on our system as a credit meaning that you can use this as part of a deposit or towards a balance on another holiday.

For the avoidance of doubt, only 50% of the original booking deposit (as detailed earlier in these terms and conditions) will be entered into the guaranteed deposit scheme, flight upgrade part payments are not part of the guaranteed deposit scheme.

The guaranteed deposit cannot be exchanged for cash.

Your guaranteed deposit can be used by you or passed to a friend providing that you advise us of this in writing.

Guaranteed Deposits must be used within two years of the holiday cancellation date.

5. CANCELLATIONS BY ONE TRAVELLER LTD.

5.1. One Traveller Ltd. tries never to cancel a holiday. If the number of passengers on a particular date is too low we will, subject to a minimum of 42 days warning, either cancel the departure and offer an alternative date or offer a full refund.

5.2. One Traveller Ltd. cannot be held responsible for any additional services including flights which you book outside the terms of your itinerary or our brochure or website. Please note that all flights can be subject to change.

6. ALTERATIONS BY ONE TRAVELLER LTD.

6.1. Occasionally we have to make changes for reasons of flight cancellations, schedule changes or 'force majeure'. Except where otherwise expressly stated in these booking conditions, we cannot accept any liability or pay any compensation if we have to cancel or change your holiday for reasons of 'force majeure'. In these booking conditions force majeure means any event which we or our suppliers could not, even with all due care, foresee or avoid. Such events may include war or threat of war, riot, civil strife, terrorist activity, industrial dispute, natural or nuclear disaster, adverse weather conditions, fire and similar events outside our control.

6.2. Your booking is accepted on the understanding that you realise that the tourism infrastructure in relation to both travel and accommodation in other parts of the world may be lower than you would expect in the UK. No refunds will be given for services not utilised.

6.3. If there is a minor alteration then we will try to notify you, though we are not obliged to do so, nor are we obliged to pay compensation. For clarity, a minor alteration on a flight time change is less than four hours.

6.4. As you are part of an organised holiday, the Tour Manager may at any time during the course of a holiday terminate the participation of a member of the party if he/she reasonably considers it necessary for the health and safety of that person or should their behaviour be disruptive or aggressive towards any other members of the party. In this situation, the person(s) concerned will be required to leave the accommodation or other services. We will have no further responsibility toward such person(s) including any return travel arrangements. No refunds will be made and we will not pay any expenses or costs incurred as a result of the termination.

7. SURCHARGES

7.1. We reserve the right to apply surcharges to our holiday prices only where we believe it is unavoidable and only in the event of:

i) Governmental action, ii) Airport charges, iii) Aircraft fuel costs, or iv) Extreme currency fluctuations.

7.2. Once we have sent you a Holiday Confirmation Invoice no surcharges will be made.

8. LIABILITY

8.1. Should you suffer death, personal injury or illness arising out of an activity forming part of your holiday arrangements we will accept responsibility unless there has been no fault on our part or our suppliers' or the cause was your own fault, or one which neither we nor our suppliers could have anticipated or avoided even with all due care being paid.

8.2. Where death or personal injury is suffered in the course of air, road, rail or sea travel we limit our liability to compensate you in accordance with the relevant international law conventions.

8.3. Where the cause of death or personal injury is the act or omission of our agents, suppliers or sub-contractors our acceptance of liability is subject to you assigning to us your rights against them and to your co-operation with us in any legal action we may wish to take against them.

8.4. The maximum liability for any claim other than for death, personal injury or illness will be limited to the price paid for the holiday.

8.5. All personal identification documentation when posted by us within the UK by Royal Mail Special Delivery and is tracked at all times. One Traveller cannot be held responsible for any financial implications should any items be lost or stolen in transit causing you to be unable to travel.

9. TRAVEL INSURANCE

It is an essential condition of you booking a holiday that you take out adequate holiday insurance covering at least circumstances leading to the cancellation of your booking and providing sufficient medical cover for illness or injury and repatriation while overseas. You must provide us with the name of your insurers, your policy number and their 24-hour emergency contact number before you travel. 15. YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

15.2. Documentation

Travellers with full British passports should ensure that they have sufficient pages for entry and exit stamps and ensure where required that their passports have at least six months to run after return to the UK. The entry requirements for British Citizens may differ to those for British Subjects, British Dependent Territories Citizens, British Nationals (Overseas Citizens),

British Protected Persons or any other British passports. Please check your passport carefully and if you are not specifically a British Citizen with a UK issued passport, you must check passport and visa requirements with the Embassy or Consulate of the country(ies) you are travelling to or through. Nationals of other countries should check requirements with the relevant embassies. The names that appear on your airline/cruise tickets should be the same as the names in your passport. On your booking form you must notify us of the names as they appear in your passport. If the names in your flight/cruise reservations are incorrect they may not be easy to change and may incur charges.

15.3. Health
